### *The Anna Freud Lecture*

#### ***The Trauma of Actualized Unconscious Phantasies: Internal and External Fields of Reference***

**Maurice Apprey, PhD, FIPA, presenter**

In his Anna Freud Lecture, Dr. Apprey will address how external fields of reference and internal fields of reference to trauma gather into the public space of the psychoanalytic relationship—a decidedly intersubjective field where humans reconstitute the way they situate themselves in the world. He will provide clinical examples from both child and adult cases in order to address the topic of this year's scientific meetings—The Impact of Trauma: The Mind in Times of Social Violence and Social Change.

**Maurice Apprey, PhD, FIPA**, Professor of Psychiatry and Neurobehavioral Sciences at the University Of Virginia School of Medicine, studied under Anna Freud at the Hampstead Clinic/Anna Freud Centre in London, where he completed his child and adolescent psychoanalytic training in 1979. His subsequent training in adult psychoanalysis was completed at the Psychoanalytic Training Institute of NYFS, where he is a supervising and training analyst. He is certified by the Board of Professional Standards of the American Psychoanalytic Association as both a child and adult psychoanalyst. He is an IPA supervising analyst for candidates in Turkey. Alongside his psychoanalytic training, Dr. Apprey studied the Continental philosophies of Edmund Husserl, Georges Politzer, Maurice Merleau-Ponty, Gaston Bachelard and others for his PhD, under the American phenomenological psychological researcher Amedeo P. Giorgi. For his doctoral degree in Management at Case Western Reserve University he studied social change management. Dr. Apprey is the author of *Intersubjectivity, Projective Identification and Otherness* (Duchesne University Press) and the English language translator of George Politzer's *Critique des Fondements de la Psychologie (Critique of the Foundations of Psychology: The Psychology of Psychoanalysis)*, Duchesne University Press).
